

静岡県公立入試2015年 対話文

次の英文は、静岡県でホームステイを始めたアメリカ人のジム(Jim)と、ホームステイ先の健太(Kenta)との会話である。この英文を読んで、①～⑤の問いに答えなさい。(12点)

(Kenta takes Jim to a ramen restaurant for the first time.)

Jim: Can I see the menu?

Kenta: Sure.

Jim: Thank you. Oh, there are many kinds of *ramen* on it. Let's see... Kenta, [ア to イ which ウ the best one エ eat オ is]?

Kenta: How about this? It's really good. I'll order it.

Jim: Then I'll order (㉓) one, too.

(A waiter brings two hand towels and two glasses of water. Kenta and Jim order their ramen.)

Jim: How do I use this hot hand towel?

Kenta: Before eating, we make our hands clean by wiping them (㉔) it. We call it *oshibori*.

Jim: Oh, that's a nice service. In America, we usually have paper napkins to wipe our hands, but I haven't seen *oshibori* before. Hot *oshibori* is good on a cold day like today. I like it.

Kenta: Waiters usually give us cold *oshibori* in summer, too.

Jim: Wow! They really take care of us.

Kenta: They understand what the right service is and when the right time for it is. Do you know the word *omotenashi*? It's a Japanese word (㉕) means good service.

Jim: That's nice. Oh, look! The waiter brought our *ramen*. Let's eat.

(Just then Jim knocks his glass over. Kenta uses his and Jim's *oshibori* to wipe the table.)

Kenta:

Jim: Yes, thank you. I'm sorry you cannot use your *oshibori* any more.

Kenta: It's all right. Sometimes we use *oshibori* like this.

(Soon the waiter brings new *oshibori*. Kenta and Jim wipe their hands.)

Jim: The waiter gave us new *oshibori* just when we needed them. I'm really glad. I think it's *omotenashi*.

Kenta: Yes. Do you like *omotenashi*?

Jim: Of course!
