

静岡県公立入試2016年 長文読解

次の英文は、中学生の由美子(Yumiko)が、学校のキャンプ(camp)で、同級生の真奈(Mana)とのできごとを振り返って書いたものである。この英文を読んで、(1)~(7)の問いに答えなさい。(16点)
